

Materials in contact with Food : Stainless Steel

The stainless steel products produced by Columbus Stainless conform to the requirements of the European Parliament and of the Council as given in Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004 on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food, and the subsequent amendments of Regulation (EC) No 596/2009.

To ensure this, the manufacturing process adheres to the requirements as set out in Regulation (EC) No 2023/2006 on good manufacturing practice for materials and articles intended to come into contact with food.

Information on the correct application and selection of materials in contact with food has been published by the European Hygiene Engineering and Design Group (EHEDG) under the section for stainless steels, and can be consulted.



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
