

Directive 2000/53/EC on End-of-Life Vehicles (ELV)

Columbus Stainless confirms that all its stainless steel products conform to the Directive 2000/53/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 September 2000 on end-of life vehicles.

- The manufacturing process consumes high volumes of recycled materials, including scrap from dismantled end-of-life vehicles via a network of approved metal recyclers.
- During manufacturing, inclusion in the product of hazardous materials like lead, mercury, cadmium and hexavalent chromium are avoided.
- The stainless steel product contains a high recycled fraction and is fully recyclable.
